





[C] I keep a [G] close watch on this heart of [C] mine

Because your [G] mine, I walk the [C] line.




I find it [G] very, very easy to be [C] true

But that [G7] train keeps a 'rolling, on down to san An [C] ton,




[C] Well if they freed me from this prison, if that railroad train were mine
