



# BY THE LIGHT OF THE SILVERY MOON .. MEDLEY


[G] By the light, of the silvery [A7] moon, I want to [D7] spoon

We'll be cuddling [E7] soon, [A7] by the [D7] silvery [G] moon. [D7]




By the [G] light, of the silvery [A7] moon, I want to [D7] spoon

We'll be cuddling [E7] soon, [A7] by the [D7] silvery [G] moon [D7] [G] [STOP]




[TACIT] When whip o' wills [G] call, and evening is nigh

[E7] Will lead me to [A7] my [D7] blue [G] heaven. [G7]




I'll see a [C] smiling face, a [E7] fireplace, a [Am] cosy room.
