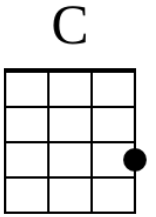
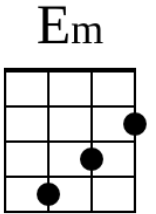


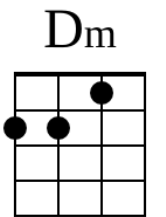
[C] Beneath it's snowy [Em] mantle cold and [Dm] clean,

 And [G7] speaks to me of flowers that will bloom again in [C] spring



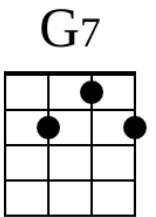
When I was young my [Em] heart was young then [Dm] too
